
1965 Mid-year Corvette Powerglide shifter



The images included here were made as I restored the Powerglide shifter in my 65. I cannot vouch for the originality of the components. It is shown here as a I found it and as I cleaned it up.






















Shifter boot retainer







Neutral safety and back-up light switch mounted to shifter




Here you can see the tab on the shifter arm engaged in the neutral safety/BU light switch


















Spring to lock out reverse
