G101 - On top of the frame rail under the power brake booster.







G104 - Just above the oil filter on the side of the block.

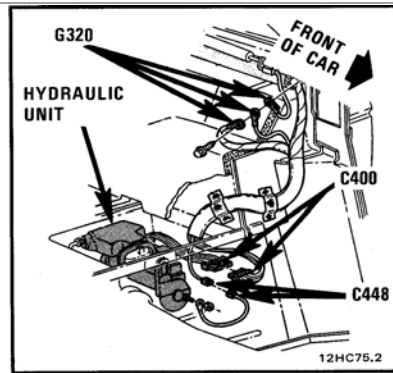


Figure B - LH Side Of Cargo Compartment

G320 - On the driver's door striker pillar next to the rear compartment lamp.

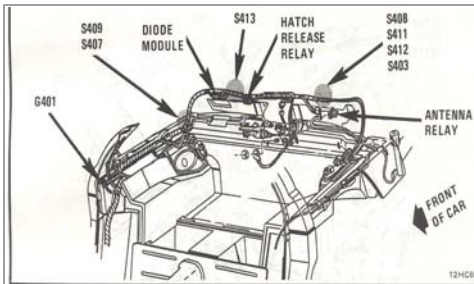


Figure A - Rear Cargo Compartment
