



February 01, 2020 I have always liked these tires. So far they have had the best grip, both in the dry, wet, and snow. My only gripe is the price. But in some cases going cheap, you get what you pay for. I drive a 2014 Mazda 6 grand touring, so I can only give my impression of them in that car, which has a stiffer suspension with a wide wheel base and a wide tire footprint, which all offers better performance. But given the multiple types of tires I've driven, these have far better performed.

The only reason I'm replacing them at 40k miles is because a screw punctured one of my tires at the sidewall. But I believe I could have gotten another 20k-30k miles out of them. I've decided to try a less expensive brand, still highly rated, but doesn't hurt the budget as much.




